Creative Writing

How to create a place where you feel comfortable:

- Use your favorite pen (pencil) and your favorite paper.
- Listen to music. Use headphones – do not disturb others.

How to find first ideas:

- Start a list ... I love ... I hate ...
- Take a walk, choose 3 to 7 words (randomly) and relate them to your topic; connect them.
- Take this sentence as a starting point.
- Scribble. Write down what comes to mind. Use little doodles and sketches.
- Write down the first words that come to mind when you see the first letter of the alphabet one word at a time connected with your topic.
- Interview a classmate about your topic or borrow an idea from him/her.

How to put your ideas in a proper order:

- Write your words on sticky notes.
- Cut them out.
- Arrange them in groups and/or put them into a wheel.

• Write the topic in the middle and circle it.

• Write a random circle and draw a line between the two words.

First three words for each subplot:

• Think of qualities, interests first and arrange them in a clockwise circle.
