## Jack-in-the-box

*You need*

*2 pieces of Origami paper (15 x 15 cm)*

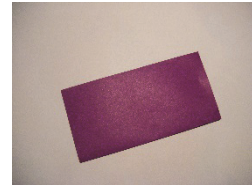
*2 strips of coloured paper (approximately 2,5 x 30 cm)*

*1 small piece of white paper for the face*

*glue*

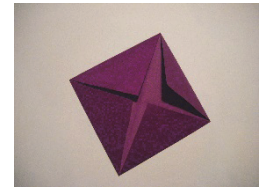
Take one 15 x 15 cm square.

**1. Fold it in half. Open it again.**

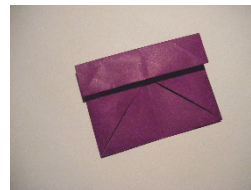


**2. Repeat Step 1 from the other side.**

**3. Fold the four corners to the center.**



**4. Fold the top half to the center.  
Fold the bottom half to the center.**



**5. Open it again.**

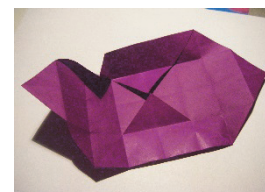


**6. Repeat Steps 4 and 5 on the left and the right.**

**7. Pull back two opposite corners.**



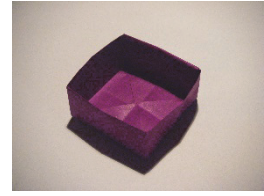
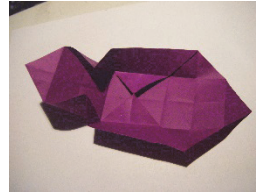
**8. Fold the top and bottom sides along the dotted line.**

9. Fold the left side along the dotted line. Fold the corners into the box and, at the same time, fold the corners to the center of the box.



10. Repeat Step 6 for the right side.
11. Take the other 15 x 15 cm square and repeat steps 1 – 6.

12. Take the two paper strips and glue them together at a 90° degree angle. Fold the bottom paper strip over the top strip, the top strip over the bottom strip, the bottom strip over the top strip and so on, until you have used up both paper strips. Glue the ends together.



13. Glue one end to the bottom of the box.
14. Use the white paper to cut out a round shape for the face. Draw a face on it and glue it to the other end of the paper strips.
15. Close the box and press Jack-in-the-box down. When you open the box, he will jump out.
